Criteria for Selection

The purpose of this Scholarship is to provide an opportunity for a qualifying EDMSSA member employee or immediate family member working towards a two year trade/technical school or college/university degree.

The EDMSSA Scholarship will be awarded on a combined basis of need and scholastic achievement. The applicant must be planning to pursue an associate's degree or bachelor's degree at a trade/technical school or college/university accredited in the state in which it is located. The enrollment status must be a full time student and the student must maintain a 3.0 GPA minimum.

Application, Financial and General Information, three references, school transcript and one page essay. The scholarship application package must be received by March 31. The winner will be selected before/by May 31.

If for any reason the scholarship recipient cannot, or does not, accept the awarded scholarship, the runner-up may be eligible for the scholarship.
